- Request forgiveness: “Can you find it in your heart to . . . ?”

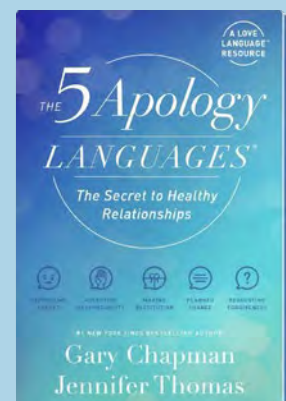

Associates in Christian Counseling is a non-profit professional counseling center with the heart of a ministry. Associates has been serving Winston-Salem and surrounding areas for over 30 years, as well as a supporting center in Surry County.

We have served more than **25,400** clients and provided over **\$3.6** million in Client Assistance Funds and Ministry Discounts in pro bono or reduced fee counseling to those with financial needs. Our staff of nine mental health professionals includes both clinical psychologists and licensed counselors. Associates is also an internship training site for graduate students pursuing their degrees in mental health care.

Associates provides comprehensive mental health services, including psychological assessment, individual, marital, and family therapy. Services are provided to children, adolescents, adults, couples, and families, ages 4 and up. Associates provides professional mental health services to all who seek them regardless of race, creed, or financial status. Associates' website receives more than 5,000 visits per month while our free e-newsletter goes out to more than 800 local pastors, physicians, donors, clients, and other friends of the ministry.
